Cayman National Teams Up to Support the Cancer Society

Photographs and messages from the Sister Islands’ residents may be sent to Grand Cayman for display when donations are submitted at their respective branches.

The cost to display a message and photograph on the wall is CI\$5.00 or 4 spaces for CI\$12.00. Persons may write a special message and/or place a copy of a passport-size photograph on the Wall (original photos will not be accepted).
