Cayman National Hosts the Harvard Business School Rugby Team

The Harvard Business School Rugby (HBS) team will be in Grand Cayman this weekend to play against the Cayman Islands Rugby team, help raise funds for the Cayman Islands Crisis Centre, and learn more about the local financial industry.

Every year the Harvard Business School Rugby team travels somewhere to play rugby as part of their "international tour". It is a warm-up to their inter-collegiate championships. This year the team narrowed the choice to Ireland, Rome (Italy) and the Cayman Islands. Todd Bice, a member of the team, previously worked for the Cayman Islands Shipping Registry and hence the decision to visit the Cayman Islands was made.

The Harvard Business School Rugby Club is comprised of Harvard graduate students, the majority being MBA candidates from the Harvard Business School and others from the Harvard Medicine, Law and Arts & Sciences Schools.
